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**Essential Facility Security Measures for Warmer Months** 

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## 1. Seasonal Maintenance for Security Systems

Inspect all exterior and interior cameras for wear and tear

Clean lenses and housings on surveillance cameras

Test intercom and alarm systems for functionality

Schedule maintenance for door hardware and access control systems

Ensure all batteries and backup power supplies (UPS) are fully charged

# 2. Outdoor Security Readiness

Trim trees and shrubs that could obstruct sightlines or cameras

Secure and inspect lighting in parking lots, courtyards, and loading docks

Test motion sensors and outdoor alarms for responsiveness

Inspect fencing and perimeter barriers for damage or weak points

Use weather-resistant enclosures for outdoor cameras and access readers

## 3. Managing Access During Extended Hours

Review and update employee, vendor, and visitor access permissions

Ensure credentialing systems are current (badges, mobile credentials, biometrics)

Monitor high-traffic entry points to prevent tailgating

Enable time-based access controls for after-hours restrictions

Use integrated access logs to spot anomalies or unauthorized access

#### 4. Power & Environmental Resilience

Test backup generators and emergency power systems

Check ventilation and cooling in IT and security equipment rooms

Install or maintain surge protectors to shield equipment during storms

Consider solar-powered lighting or surveillance for remote areas

# **5. Emergency Preparedness**

Update emergency contacts and response procedures

Conduct seasonal security drills with staff and contractors

Review communication protocols for outages or severe weather

Ensure critical data is backed up and remotely accessible

Evaluate insurance coverage for seasonal weather events
